

2010 Tax Preparation - Senior Residents of Union-Snyder Counties

Trained volunteers will be offering tax assistance for the elderly and disabled free of charge. Programs such as the IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA) and the Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs offer assistance with tax preparation for those who qualify. In addition, trained volunteers may help with special credits, particularly Credit for the Elderly or the Disabled.

Appointments can be scheduled for the VITA Tax program by calling (570) 374-0181. The appointments will be held at PA Careerlink in Selinsgrove (sit down site), Middle Creek Community Center in Beaver Springs, SUM Child Development in Lewisburg or SUM Child Development in Mifflinburg.

Charles Thomas, an AARP certified tax counselor, along with other trained individuals will be offering tax preparation assistance to low to moderate income senior citizens of Union County. Charles Thomas along with AARP tax aides will be available free of charge for basic returns. Appointments will be held at the Union County library and can be made by calling (570) 523-8812. Appointments will begin on February 9th.

Bill Reardon, another AARP tax counselor, will be holding appointments for Snyder County residents. Appointments can be made anytime by calling (570) 374-1199. Feel free to leave a message. These appointments will be held at the senior centers in Beaver Springs, Penns Creek and Selinsgrove and will begin February 2nd.
